

Preparation of Final Manuscript Submission

5 STEPS are required to complete the Final Paper Submission

STEP 1: Use one of the iEECON2020 templates for your paper (latex or word). Templates are in this link: <https://www.eeat-conf.com/ieecon2020/index.php>

STEP 2: Add the copyright notice to the bottom of the first page of your source document.

- For papers in which all authors are employed by the US government, the copyright notice is: **U.S. Government work not protected by U.S. copyright**
- For papers in which all authors are employed by a Crown government (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is: **978-1-7281-3076-7/20/\$31.00 ©2020 Crown**
- For papers in which all authors are employed by the European Union, the copyright notice is: **978-1-7281-3076-7/20/\$31.00©2020 European Union**
- For all other papers the copyright notice is: **978-1-7281-3076-7/20/\$31.00 ©2020 IEEE**

STEP 3: Convert to PDF using IEEE PDF eXpress

Authors must create a PDF according to the IEEE PDF Specification for IEEE Xplore. All submissions MUST be IEEE Xplore compliant and the only way to ensure this is to use IEEE's PDF eXpress. Authors must check their papers for iEECON 2020 using the IEEE PDF eXpress system at <http://www.pdf-express.org>

Here are the basic instructions for using PDF eXpress:

First-time users: Go to <http://www.pdf-express.org>. Select "New Users - Click Here", then enter your email address and a memorable password, and

For each conference paper, click "Create New Title".

Enter identifying text for the paper (title is recommended).

Click "Submit PDF for checking" or "Submit Source Files for Conversion".

click "Browse" and navigate to file, and click "Upload File". You will receive online and email confirmation of successful upload.

You will receive an email with the IEEE PDF eXpress-converted PDF attached.

If your PDF submitted fails the check: Submit your source file again by clicking "Try again", read the PDF Check Report, then click "The PDF Check Report" to get information on possible solutions.

IMPORTANT : Any changes made to a PDF after IEEE PDF eXpress conversion or PDF Checking may invalidate IEEE Xplore compatibility. This includes headers, page numbers, copyright notice, watermarks, etc. If any of these elements are desired, they should be added to the document before a PDF is created.

STEP 4: submit your final camera ready as **WORD and PDF to the iEECON submission system at <https://www.eeaat-conf.com/ieecon2020/index.php>.**

STEP 5: complete the IEEE copyright transfer.

In this step, the **IEEE will send the emails to the corresponding authors with links and credentials to access IEEE Electronic Copyright Form (eCF)**. Please fill-in the eCF form and submit the copyright to the IEEE. We will monitor this process to see the completion of IEEE copyright transfer. Your paper will not be published in IEEE eXplore, if the IEEE copyright transfer is not completed!!!
